Time: 0800-1600 The class will be 6 to 8 hours.

Location: The old Carpers Valley Golf Course, at the end of Coverstone Drive, beside the Frederick County Public Safety Building, 1080 Coverstone Drive, Winchester, VA 22602

Meals & Accommodations: This is one day class and does not require the student to stay over in Winchester, if they prefer not to. Otherwise, students will be responsible for their own food and housing. There are several restaurants in the vicinity. The class will break for lunch and you may pack lunch or go out at your discretion.

Course Content:

The class will be a "skill development" training program for Basic Level Tracker desiring to increase his/her training level and spring refresher for certified students. Emphasis will be on seeing and interpreting sign according to the JHPTS glossary and methodology. Students at all training levels will be individually challenged with additional advanced tracking concepts and techniques.

Anyone interested in human visual tracking is welcome and JHPTS certified students are encouraged to attend. Please note; this is a JHPTS based training in which all instructors and students are to perform tasks as defined within the program. These in-house training hours are applied to certification maintenance. Currently, TRAC is the only agency presenting JHPTS tracking methodology east of the Mississippi.

Student Needs: Students should be physically fit and equipped for SAR field response. Field practice will continue during any inclement weather conditions, students should be properly prepared with wet/dry, cold/hot weather gear. Knee pads may be helpful.

Students need to bring a pen/pencil, note pad, small measuring tape, a tracking stick or 5/8 inch dowel or similar, 36 to 40 inches long, with two rubber bands to use as a tracking stick and a three-cell flashlight.

Registration:

For class planning purposes, it is requested for students to pre-register for this course. However, walk-ons are always welcome and will be integrate in the training exercises.
